**SOC 500 INDEPENDENT STUDY OR RESEARCH1-3 Credits**

Study or research in an area of special interest. The number of credit hours is determined by the topic and the amount of work required.

**Add Consent:** Instructor Consent

**Requirements:** Permission of instructor and academic dean required.

**SOC 530 TOPICS IN SOCIOLOGY3 Credits**

Special topics in Sociology.

**Notes:** May be repeated with a change of emphasis.

**SOC 535 ADVANCED SOCIAL PSYCHOLOGY3 Credits**

A study of four perspectives in Social Psychology. Two primarily psychological; Gestalt and Freudian. Two primarily sociological; Exchange and Symbolic Interaction. Includes student reading and interpretation of primary and secondary sources in these four areas.

**SOC 655 SCHOLARLY PROJECT1-3 Credits**

For students selecting Plan II, as listed under Program Requirements.

Scholarly project pertaining to a field of specialization. Designed in consultation with the student's graduate committee and includes an extensive paper summarizing the project.

**Requirements:** Must complete three (3) credit hours.
