Costs

The Board of Trustees for the Nebraska State Colleges establishes a schedule of tuition and fees to be charged by the State Colleges (NSCS Board Policy 6500 (<https://www.nscs.edu/policy-manual/detail/122-6021-tuition%20rates/>)). Specific courses may have additional assessed fees.

Online courses are assessed at a combined-tuition-and-fees set rate per credit hour. See current tuition and fees. (<https://www.csc.edu/businessoffice/tuition-and-fees/>)
